Student Digital Technology and Internet User Agreement



Digital technologies are tools that can help us learn at school in all sorts of ways. Some of these ways include looking at interesting things online, talking to people, creating music and media, gathering new ideas, and learning how to use tools.

When we use digital technologies and online spaces it's important that we learn ways to keep ourselves safe, and that we make positive choices in ways we behave when we are online. At GEIS we call this being a 'digital citizen' and good digital citizens help to make our school a safe and positive place for everyone.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

As a student of GEIS and also part of our community, we ask you to help make our school a place that is safe, friendly, and fair. This means taking our school values and acting on them whether you're online, or offline, and help to make our school a positive place to learn, connect and play. This is being a 'digital citizen'.

As a digital citizen, you will:

- Keep it kind. Think about others online and talk or share in respectful ways.
- Keep it to yourself. Keep passwords and information about yourself and other people private and offline as it can be easily shared, viewed, screenshot, or changed by others to mean different things. Nothing is private online.
- Keep it careful. Things you do or say online can be seen by others, so be careful to share the things you can feel proud of, or would be happy sharing with someone face to face.
- Keep it positive. Always respect others online and communicate in a positive, respectful way.
- Post with caution. Anything you post or do online can influence what people think of you. Put your best foot forward online.
- **Don't believe everything you see.** Always think carefully about the information you see online not everything is true. If you are unsure of something, talk to a teacher or trusted adult.
- Avoid online bullying. Creating or forwarding content that is harmful or hurtful towards someone else is not okay at any time. Sending multiple messages to somebody who doesn't want them is also considered online bullying and is never okay.
- **Be security smart.** Keep personal information secure by using strong passwords and not sharing them with other students. Keep private all personal information on the internet, such as full names, ages and phone numbers.
- **Respect others' rights.** Always ask first if you need to use someone else's device, online sites, and their image, ideas, creations or work that's stored online.
- **Recognise other's work.** When we use or take others' work or ideas from the internet, we need to make sure we copy or use these in ways that are okay because there are rules about this. Your teacher will help you to use things you find online in the right ways.
- Use digital technology sensibly. Use digital technology at school for educational learning, with teacher permission.
- Seek help. Sometimes you or someone you know will feel unsafe or come across bad or harmful content online. If this happens, talk to a trusted adult about what can be done.

ONLINE INCIDENTS

Despite the good things technology offers and people's best intentions, sometimes things will go wrong. Sometimes these things are on purpose, and sometimes they are accidents. GEIS will support you if something goes wrong online.

Online bullying. Online bullying is not accepted at our school. If you or somebody else is being bullied or criticised online, report it. Keep the content so we can investigate it. Stop any further contact with the person who is bullying. You can report on the GEIS Student Website for help. It's important to think about sharing what's happened with a trusted adult like a parent, a member of your whānau, or someone else who looks after you.

Report a problem. We need your help to keep our school safe. If you see something on the school systems that you don't think should be there, we need you to report it as soon as you can to Miss Heeringa or Mr Prisk. This is really helpful and important, so that the school can find out what the problem is and fix it as soon as possible, and help those who might need it.

Family Zone. While at school, all student internet use is monitored by Linewize by Family Zone. Using Linewize cyber safety solutions, the school is able to gain visibility and management of all access to online environments from devices on the school network. This allows the school to filter and enforce its acceptable use policy on the device during school hours to keep everyone safe online.

BRINGING YOUR OWN DEVICE - BYOD

- All devices brought to school are the student's own responsibility and the insurance for the device is the parent/caregiver's responsibility. The school holds no responsibility for any loss or damage that might occur either accidentally or intentionally.
- Students & families agree to be responsible for the proper care of their personal device, including any costs of repair or replacement.
- All devices must arrive at school each day fully charged.
- Devices are to be used only under adult supervision between 8:30am and 3pm.
- School staff retain the right to collect and examine any device that is suspected of being in breach of any aspect of the Student Digital Technology and Internet User Agreement. Violation of the User Agreement may result in the loss of the use of the device at school.

MOBILE PHONES

- All phones will be locked in the class safe during the day.
- Phones will only be used during school hours with permission from a teacher.
- No messages or phone calls to be made during school hours. If contact home needs to be made, this must be done through the office.
- Phones being used without teacher permission during the day or found not locked in the safe will be confiscated and handed to the office for collection by parents/caregivers.
- No images or videos of other students or staff will be recorded and/or posted on social media platforms without permission during school hours.

EMAIL & MESSAGING/COMMUNICATION

- No personal messaging, email communication, private document commenting and chat rooms to be used at school.
- Appropriate language will be used by not using profanity or insulting language on any app, site, email or communication platform.
- GEIS filters and monitors school provided student email accounts at all times, and students cannot email out of school or receive emails from outside GEIS during school hours.

RESPONSIBILITY WITH DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

- I will respect all school devices and use them with care.
- I will not access sites unrelated to my learning inc. gaming/streaming/social media etc. during school hours without permission.
- I will only listen to music with permission from the classroom teacher in charge.
- I will only use my real name for all school accounts and websites including class quizzes.
